- In order to be eligible to receive an award from St. Mary's University:
 - students admitted to the program for Fall 2018 must have paid the \$200 registration deposit **by May 31, 2018**;
 - must maintain full-time status in both the Fall 2018 and Winter 2019 terms;
 - must achieve a minimum grade of C in each course and pass practicum in the Fall 2018 term in order to receive the award in the Winter 2019 term.
- The value of the award is paid as follows:
 - half of the award is applied directly to Fall tuition and fees on or before September 5, 2018;
 - half of the award is applied directly to Winter tuition and fees on or before January 7, 2019.

H. CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

- Awards are tenable only at St. Mary's University and only for the 2018-2019 academic year.
- St. Mary's University is not responsible for awards that are cancelled after the publication of the *2018-2019 University Calendar* and the awards application.
