



## Assistant Professor of Psychology

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will have a background in the broad area of applied/counselling Psychology. Teaching responsibilities include undergraduate courses in statistics and research methodology, introductory psychology, as well as courses related to the candidate's area of expertise including at least one of the following: cross-cultural psychology, forensic psychology, community psychology, trauma, communication and counselling skills, theories of counselling. This is a research stream appointment and the teaching load is 3/3.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must have a PhD in Psychology by the date of appointment. The successful candidate will display evidence of excellence in teaching and a record of research and publication or strong potential.
