## F. PAYMENT OF AWARDS

- In order to be eligible to receive an award from St. Mary's University:
  - students admitted to the program for Fall 2021 must have paid the \$200 registration deposit;
  - must maintain full-time status in both the Fall 2021 and Winter 2022 terms;
  - must achieve a minimum grade of C in each course in order to receive the award in the Winter 2022 term.
- The value of the award is paid as follows:
  - half of the award is applied directly to Fall tuition and fees on or before September 22, 2021;
  - half of the award is applied directly to Winter tuition and fees on or before January 24, 2022.

## G. CONDITIONS OF AWARDS

- Awards are tenable only at St. Mary's University and only for the 2021-2022 academic year.
- St. Mary's University is not responsible for awards that are cancelled after the publication of the *2021-2022 University Calendar* and the awards application.
